Practitioners protect their esoteric knowledge, but they also engage in a kind of "lure and withdrawal"--- a performance of secrecy--- because secrecy functions as what might be

called "symbolic capital." Sieler argues that varmakalai is, above all, a matter of texts in practice; knowledge transmission between teacher and student conveys tacit, non-verbal knowledge, and constitutes a "moral economy." It is not merely plain facts that are communicated, but also moral obligations, ethical conduct and tacit, bodily knowledge.
