(2) There are six recognized Armor Regiments and 32 Cavalry Regiments in the Regimental system for the Army National Guard (See Appendix A-2). (3) The lowest numbered CONUS-based battalion of the regiment will be designated regimental home-base having regimental responsibility and will maintain the regimental colors and memorabilia. When all battalions are OCONUS, the lowest numbered OCONUS battalion or squadron assumes regimental

responsibility and maintains regimental colors and memorabilia (See Appendix A). Exceptions to the home-base battalion concept are 2CR, 3CR, and 11 ACR; Regimental HQs will assume regimental responsibility.
