Most of the papers delivered on that day were published in a previous volume, *Brisbane: Squatters, settlers and surveyors*, BHG Papers No.16. Although it was intended that the focus of this collection would be primarily immigration, the more general term

English Midlands emigrate to Australia • the effect of the short-lived immigration policy which sought to 'populate' Queensland with skilled tradesmen • the effectiveness of emigration agents in promoting Queensland to the Scots • the story of a Brisbane wharf which witnessed changes in shipping, cargo and the ultimate demise of the city's industrial heritage Not all the schemes and dreams were successful, but overall the chapters tell of groups and

individuals who were prepared to rise to each new challenge in their determination to make a better life for themselves in early Brisbane.
