A obra dramática de Roberto Vidal Bolaño é o relato da carismática procura dunha poética teatral propia. O libro traduce en termos divulgativos unha complexa aventura artística seguindo o rastro dun creador xenial que ilumina os vinte e cinco anos finais do segundo milenio. Neste alambique destíllase un insólito fenómeno cultural colectivo, metonimia da vitalidade dun ambiente social ben próximo aínda que xa admite unha visión histórica. O volume iníciase reivindicando o valor do autor e reconstruíndo a súa carreira para logo catalogar e clasificar as súas obras, avanzando unha lectura temática dos proxectos en que empeñou a vida. A proposta remata esgotando a análise dun proxecto, a primeira superproducción plenamente galega, Agasallo de sombras. Deste modo supérase o perfil externo e penétrase no obradoiro creativo do autor mediante a reconstrución virtual dos procesos de creación e explotación escénica e a análise dos textos desde dous focos complementarios, o dramatólxico e o teórico-crítico.

El comentari cronològic segons la data d'estrena a Barcelona de les seixanta-cinc pel·lícules considerades permet analitzar contextualment el sorgiment, l'evolució i el final del cicle genèric més important de la cinematografía catalana. Tanmateix, l'aspecte cinematogràfic és només una part del llibre. El context dels films no es limita als condicionants sociopolítics o industrials; el gènere criminal es manifesta també en altres mitjans com ara la novel·la (llibres i col·leccions periòdiques, la ràdio i finalment la televisió). Els diferents mitjans, així com la interrelació entre ells, es tracten en capítols específics que aporten dades rellevants sobre aspectes de la cultura popular poc estudiats fins ara. A part de l'excel·lència individual d'algunes de les obres analitzades, el conjunt d'elles reflecteix les difícils condicions en què es movia l'activitat cultural en plena dictadura franquista, sota la qual les publicacions o estrenes teatrals en català tenien una dificultat afegida. Aquest rerefons històric es fa notar contínuament en el text.
