Completed just weeks before his death, the lectures in this volume mark a critical juncture in the

career of Roland Barthes, in which he declared the intention, deeply felt, to write a novel. Unfolding over the course of two years, Barthes engaged in a unique pedagogical experiment: he combined teaching and writing to "simulate" the trial of novel-writing, exploring every step of the creative process along the way. Barthes's lectures move from the desire to write to the actual decision making, planning, and material act of producing a novel. He meets the difficulty of transitioning from short, concise notations (exemplified by his favorite literary form, haiku) to longer, uninterrupted flows of narrative, and he encounters a number of setbacks. Barthes takes solace in a diverse group of writers, including Dante, whose La Vita Nuova was similarly inspired by the death of a loved one, and he turns to classical philosophy, Taoism, and the works of François-René Chateaubriand, Gustave Flaubert, Franz Kafka, and Marcel Proust. This book uniquely includes eight elliptical plans for Barthes's unwritten novel, which he titled Vita Nova, and lecture notes that sketch the critic's views on photography. Following on The Neutral: Lecture Course at the Collège de France (1977-1978) and a third forthcoming collection of Barthes lectures, this volume provides an intensely personal account of the labor and love of writing.

In Proust's Songbook, Jennifer Rushworth analyzes and theorizes the presence and role of songs in Marcel Proust's novel À la recherche du temps perdu (In Search of Lost Time). Instead of focusing on instrumental music and large-scale forms such as symphonies and opera, as is common in Proust musical studies, Rushworth argues for the centrality of songs and lyrics in Proust's opus. Her work analyzes the ways in which the author inserted songs at key turning points in his novel and how he drew inspiration from contemporary composers and theorists of song. Rushworth presents detailed readings of five moments of song in À la recherche du temps perdu, highlighting the songs' significance by paying close attention to their lyrics, music, composers, and histories. Rushworth interprets these episodes through theoretical reflections on song and voice, drawing particularly from the works of Reynaldo Hahn and Roland Barthes. She argues that songs in Proust's novel are connected and resonate with one another across the different volumes yet also shows how song for Proust is a solo, amateur, and intimate affair. In addition, she points to Proust's juxtapositions of songs with meditations on the notion of "mauvaise musique" (bad music) to demonstrate the existence of a blurred boundary between songs that are popular and songs that are art. According to Rushworth, a song for Proust has a special relation to repetition and memory due to its typical brevity and that song itself becomes a mode of resistance in À la Recherche—especially on the part of characters in the face of family and familial expectations. She also defines the songs in Proust's novel as songs of farewell—noting that to sing farewell is a means to resist the very parting that is being expressed—and demonstrates how songs, in formal terms, resist the forward impetus of narrative.

Cet ouvrage entend analyser et repérer le sentiment de la perte exprimé par le sujet-écrivain, tout en le définissant comme constitutif de l'acte littéraire et consubstantiel à son existence. À travers l'analyse des œuvres de Stendhal (Vie de Henry Brulard) de Proust et de Céline (Mort à crédit), ce sentiment est étudié du point de vue littéraire et psychanalytique, tout en accordant à l'analyse textuelle une primauté indispensable, révélant les hésitations, les non-dits et les silences paradoxaux de l'écriture. Chacun à leur manière, Stendhal, Proust et Céline expriment ce sentiment, notamment en ce qui concerne la perte de la relation maternelle, perte réelle, redoutée ou même, chez Céline, singulièrement exposée dans un refus du fonctionnement oedipien classique. La lecture de ces trois œuvres souligne ainsi un fondement du sujet psychique sublimé dans l'acte littéraire.

Dieser Band versammelt die wichtigsten Texte von Roland Barthes über Marcel Proust: Zeitschriftenbeiträge, Vorlesungen und Vorlesungsnotizen und eine Auswahl aus Barthes' fast 3000 hinterlassenen Karteikarten zu Proust. Em *Marcel Proust e os paraísos perdidos*, Ricardo Luiz de Souza estuda alguns dos principais temas do romance proustiano o amor, o ciúme, a passagem do tempo, o fazer artístico, a arte como redenção, a aristocracia, as relações sociais buscando demonstrar como é a sensação de desilusão que, ao permear todo o texto, confere a ele unidade e organicidade. E, em oposição à desilusão que define a trajetória do Narrador, surgem e ressurgem a todo momento os paraísos perdidos que apenas no final do romance, e por intermédio da arte, são reencontrados. Essa dualidade e essa trajetória são analisadas neste livro. Trata-se, enfim, de um estudo sobre a amargura, o desencanto e o pessimismo tão presentes na obra de Proust, mas trata-se, também, de um estudo sobre a visão da arte como a dimensão na qual a condição humana do autor, do Narrador, de todos nós poderá ser reencontrada em sua inteireza e, a partir daí, ser compreendida e, quem sabe, ser redimida.
