We must not allow suspension to push out our children because ostensibly it may be ensuring them a life sentence of unemployment, crime, or even death. We say it starts at home with the parents, so if we can better understand our student's rights and the rights we have

as parents we can better prepare ourselves to advocate for our student and to hold the school district accountable for the Education of Our Children!
