Stephen Crane wrote a comprehensive description of his dog and its experience of being taken in by a Little boy. A Dark Brown Dog were published in March 1901. The story was an allegory about the Jim Crow South during Reconstruction. The dog represents emancipated slaves. Sisters of Glass J.L. Jarvis Daniel Hendrick immigrated between 1630 and 1640 to Hampton, New Hampshire and married Dorothy Pike as early as 1642. They lived in Newbury,

Massachusetts before moving to Haverhill. He died between 1700 and 1713. Includes Cady, Cory, Dow, Ingalls, Putnam and related families.
