"The low critical opinion of dramatic adaptations of prose works makes clear that the dramatic text is widely seen as unable to compete with the narrative text that it adapts. Privileging the text of a play as the site of meaning is inadequate, however, given the social nature of theatre; rather, the socio-historical context of a production must be investigated to flesh out the meaning of the text in dramatic production. Franz Kafka's The Trial 9th Cinebook

From Adam and Eve to pussy hats, people have punished, praised, pathologized, and politicized vulvas, vaginas, clitorises, and menstruation. In this graphic nonfiction book, drawn in chunky, punky pen, Swedish cartoonist Liv Strömquist traces how different cultures and traditions have shaped women's health and beyond. Her biting, informed commentary and ponytailed avatar guides the reader from the darkest chapters of history (a clitoridectomy performed on a five-year-old American child as late as 1948) to the lightest (vulvas used as architectural details as a symbol of protection). Like humorists Julie Doucet (*Dirty Plotte*), Alison Bechdel (*Dykes to*

Watch Out For), and Kate Beaton (*Hark! A Vagrant*), she uses the comics medium to reveal uncomfortable truths about how far we haven't come.

ever read in comics! With adroit leadership and often frenetic action, Herlock Sholmes is regarded as a creative triumph from duo Radilovi-Furtinger.
