Le présent numéro comporte deux groupes de contributions. Le premier, fort de 15 articles, examine les rapports entre les marins français - au niveau des officiers généraux - et la politique au cours du XXe siècle. On y voit les problèmes soulevés par la républicanisation de la Marine mais aussi le penchant maurrassien de beaucoup de marins. Les derniers drames, ceux de l'Occupation et ceux de la guerre d'Algérie, sont aussi abordés

de front. Le second groupe, beaucoup plus réduit - quatre articles -, discute l'existence et les caractéristiques d'une révolution navale au début de l'époque moderne (milieu XVIe - début XVIIIe siècle). Il s'y ajoute un article isolé mais dont les liens sont nombreux avec ces quatre textes : l'étude du financement de la Marine de Louis XIV à la fin du XVIIe siècle. L'ensemble est tout à fait neuf, et de nature à susciter d'autres recherches.
