Friedman and Schwartz's *A Monetary History of the United States, 1867-1960*, published in 1963, stands as one of the most influential economics books of the twentieth century. made on the occasion of Milton Friedman's 90th birthday, on the enduring influence of Friedman and Schwartz's work and vision.
